

# Membership of the Lyneham Flying Club

## Eligibility

All Service personnel are eligible to join the Flying Club, including members of foreign military units attached to MOD units in the UK. In addition, dependants, retired Servicemen and members of the Reserve Forces and Service youth organizations (e.g. CCF and ATC) may join. Some civilians (who do not fall into the previous categories) may be invited to become club members, but their numbers are limited by RAF regulations and they are usually required to offer some valuable service to The Club, for example; book-keeping assistance to the treasurer, flying instruction, provide access to services useful to The Club which might otherwise not be available, etc.

In order to maintain status as an RAF Charity, a significant percentage of members must come from the service. Generally speaking, because LFC membership fees are considerably lower than most civilian flying clubs, and because of the limited number of civilian vacancies, civilian members should demonstrate that they may be able to make some voluntary contribution to the running of the club. **Prospective civilian members should contact a committee member to confirm that membership will be permitted, prior to applying.**
